In April, monthly gas sales volume totaled 324.175 million cubic meters, increase by 7.0% from the previous year.

1. Gas Sales Volume

(1) Residential

The gas sales volume increased from the previous year, due to lower temperatures in March and April which caused an increase of heating and hot water demand, etc.

(2) Industrial

The gas sales volume increased from the previous year, due to our marketing efforts to create new gas demand, etc.

(3) Commercial and Others

The gas sales volume increased from the previous year, due to lower temperatures in March and April which caused an increase of air-conditioning demand, etc.

(4) Wholesale

The gas sales volume to other gas utilities increased.
