In FY2017 (from April 2017 to March 2018), gas sales volume totaled 3,954.193 million cubic meters, increase by 1.1% from the previous year.

The gas sales volume increased from the previous year, due to our marketing efforts to create new gas demand and an increase in customer facilities' operation rates, etc.

③ Commercial and Others

The gas sales volume increased from the previous year, due to our marketing efforts to create new gas demand and lower temperatures in winter which caused an increase of air-conditioning demand, etc.

4 Wholesale

The gas sales volume to other gas utilities increased.
